Finishing Up First Semester

As we welcome students back virtually to finish out this first semester, we would like to remind students and parents that first semester ends on Friday, January 15. Once grades are finalized, the final semester grades will be sent to the students' respective home schools to be used in the calculation toward high school graduation.

Monday, January 18 and Tuesday, January 19 are non-attendance days for students. Second semester will officially begin on Wednesday, January 20. At this point, we are slated to return on a hybrid schedule for second semester. The first in person day would be Thursday, January 21 for our B day students. The first in person day for our A day students will be Monday, January 25. Students will be assigned the same A day/B day designation they had for the previous hybrid schedule. The Board of Education will confirm this decision or could potentially change this plan at the January 11th meeting. Next week's update will come electronically on Tuesday, so we can communicate plans after the board meeting.

One significant change made at the last board meeting was a change in the dates for Parent Teacher Conferences. Due to the later start of second semester, we will be moving the second semester conferences to March 22 and 25. Student non-attendance days that week will be Thursday, March 25 and Friday, March 26. The following week is spring break, so students will be out March 25 – April 2. As a result, we will have a full week of school February 8-12. Originally, February 12 was slated as a non-attendance day, but we will be in session on February 12. Teachers will be in contact closer to time to set up a conference. Our spring conferences are focused on planning for the next steps in the student's training or employment.

ACT REGISTRATION INFORMATION (ACT.ORG)

If you plan on attending a four-year college or university, most colleges and universities within the Midwest utilize the ACT test and scores to determine eligibility for enrollment, placement, and in some cases scholarships. Time for seniors to take the test is running out, and many juniors may wish to take the test beginning this spring to give themselves time to retest if necessary. The cost of the ACT is \$55 without the writing portion or \$70 with the writing portion. Students potentially could receive a waiver for the fees based on eligibility. Please work with your counselor to determine if this is an option. Below you will see the next test dates and the registration deadlines. If you are utilizing a waiver, please plan ahead as it may take more time to get registered. Each testing date may have different location options.

Students planning on attending a 2 year college might be required to take the Accuplacer to determine placement and may not need the ACT. Some 2 year colleges will use the ACT content scores to determine placement. Students should check with potential colleges to determine specifically what is needed.
