As an example, a student who wants to be a chef for a career will want to enroll in as many foods classes as possible upon entering high school. Business classes could also support this career. This section of the IEP will inform what the school, parent, and student will do during the current IEP to meet their potential career goal. If outside sources (Vocational Rehabilitation, ETS, etc.) are needed to accomplish a career goal, this agency will also be addressed in this section. When you get time, check out your student's Transition plan and make sure it will assist them in getting where they want to go.
