

Screenings

During the home visits, P.A.T. parent educators are able to do a free developmental screening of children starting at age 4 months through 35 months.

Screenings for children 36 months through kindergarten age take place at New Trails Early Learning Center. Following a screening, parents may request that their child be considered for placement at New Trails Early Learning Center.

This free development screening gives parents valuable information about how their child is developing in motor, language, social, cognitive areas. Hearing and vision screenings are also included in this free service. Parents receive a personal conference and written summary of the screening results. During the conference, suggestions will be given for activities to enhance the child's learning.

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

Information Guide

The Raytown School District offers a variety of early childhood resources and services to meet the needs of your child. We offer intentionally designed programs for ages birth through 5 that meet their social, emotional, physical, and intellectual needs. You can be confident that your child is involved in a program that prepares them for a successful educational future.

New Trails Early Learning Center

New Trails offers half-day preschool for children ages 3-5. Transportation is provided. Qualifications: New Trails accepts students who have a special education diagnosis. Students who do not have special education diagnosis can also be screened to see if he/she is developing within the normal range for his/her age or in which areas the child may need help. Eligibility for Early Childhood Title 1 is based on a multi-criteria screening in the following areas: hearing, vision, articulation, developmental skills, health history, family information, and behavior observations.

Three Trails Preschool

Three Trails offers 3 programs to meet the needs of your family:

- PreK: Half-day program for children who are 4 before July 31
- Head Start: Half-day program for children ages 3-5 who meet the income qualifications
- Tuition: Full-day paid program for children ages 3-5

Three Trails Preschool exists to provide families with an early educational opportunity that promotes a safe, nurturing, and educational environment where children grow socially, emotionally, and academically. We offer intentionally designed programs for ages 3-5 that meet their social, emotional, physical and intellectual needs. Our environment is safe and fosters independence and exploration of their world. Children must be ages 3-5 to enroll.



Parents as Teachers (PAT)

Parents as Teachers is a free and voluntary early-learning program for all children prenatal to age 5. Some of the services offered are:

- Personal visits for families with children prenatal to kindergarten age
- Group events and activities
- Developmental screening for children 4 months to kindergarten age

P.A.T. offers free home visits for children ages birth - kindergarten age. Prenatal visits are also available. During a home visit, certified parent educators bring activities, handouts, and developmental information to parents. For more information, contact:
